IFHS Student Award: **Terms & Conditions**

Each IFHS-member society is be entitled to nominate one candidate per year for the IFHS Student Award. It is entirely up to the individual societies to decide how they select their own nominees.

To be eligible a candidate must have been a full-time student on a relevant undergraduate or post-graduate level course at some point during the 12 months preceding the closing date for nominations.

All nominees must declare that, if successful, they are willing and able to present a paper during the Student Presentation Session at the next Hydro conference; if they are unable to do so the prize may be withdrawn and/or offered to another candidate.

All nominations must be submitted on an official nomination form.

Word Count: Papers must be a **maximum of 2500 words** in length. This word count does **not include** references, tables or captions for figures and tables.

All completed nomination forms must be submitted to **helen@hydrographicsociety.org** by 30th April.

The IFHS Board will select and notify the winner by the end of July. These deadlines have been chosen to complement those operated by Hydro Organising Committees thereby enabling full descriptions of IFHS Student Award winners' presentations in published Conference and Technical programmes.

The winner of the IFHS Student Award will be ineligible for the Prize for the Best Student Presentation at Hydro in the same year.
